Must hold as minimum, an ICAO recognized Private Pilots Licence (Aeroplanes) (PPLA) have a current aviation medical certificate for that level of licence.

#### **Privileges of Licence**

On completion of your Multi Engine Instrument Rating you will be able to fly a multi engine piston aircraft by sole reference to flight instruments and be able to conduct ILS, NDB, VOR, VOR/DME and GPS approaches by day or night.

#### **Course**

The course includes Instrument and Night flying sequences.

#### **Course fee includes:**

##### **1. Flying**

- Dual - Flight training with an instructor.
- Solo - Flight training with the student acting as pilot in command - no instructor.

- 3.0 hours solo Cessna 310
- 20.0 hours Flight Simulator
